Taro : Yes. It took only twenty minutes by bus.

Sadao : You are right. We can get to the city faster by crossing the bridges. It used to take about one and a half hours by boat. Is this your first time to cross the bridges?

Taro : No. I have once crossed them by bike. Going by bike across the bridges was very exciting. (2)

Sadao : I know. Many people enjoy walking on the bridges on fine days.

Taro : (3)

Sadao : Well, we can get to the city and come back at any time. Before the bridges were built, we couldn't cross the sea when the weather was bad. The people can go to work in the city faster by bus or by car.
