

Takashi made a speech about his weekend in the English class. After the class, his English teacher, Ms. Johnson, came to talk to him.

Ms. Johnson : Takashi, ①

Takashi : Thank you very much, Ms. Johnson. Do you think that everyone understood my speech?

Ms. Johnson : Yes, I think so. You have a wonderful family. I understand your family grows a lot of rice and vegetables in the field. And you often help your parents there on weekends.

Takashi : You are right. My parents work there almost every day. I often help them after *judo* practice on weekends. (ア) 彼らは私に野菜の育て方を教えてくれます。

Ms. Johnson : What kinds of vegetables do you grow?

Takashi : Potatoes, cabbages, onions, and many other green vegetables.

Ms. Johnson : Oh, you grow many kinds of vegetables. Then you don't have to buy vegetables so often at a store, do you?

Takashi : ② And I'm very happy to eat the many kinds of fresh vegetables we grow.

Ms. Johnson : Eating fresh vegetables is good for your health. Do you enjoy working with your family?

Takashi : Yes, very much. My family says that now I work better than before in the field. People in my neighborhood often say that I am doing a good thing. (イ) 彼らの優しい言葉はいつも私を幸せにしてくれます。

Ms. Johnson : I know how you feel. By the way, what are you going to be in the future?

Takashi : Well, I'm very interested in vegetables. So I want to learn about them in the future.
