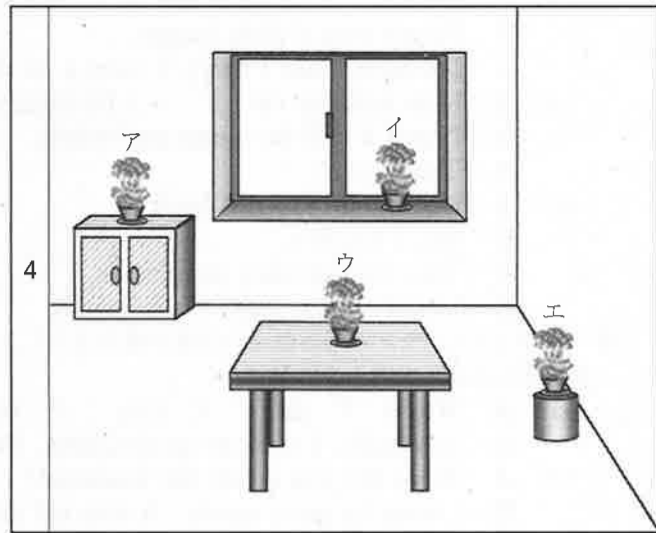
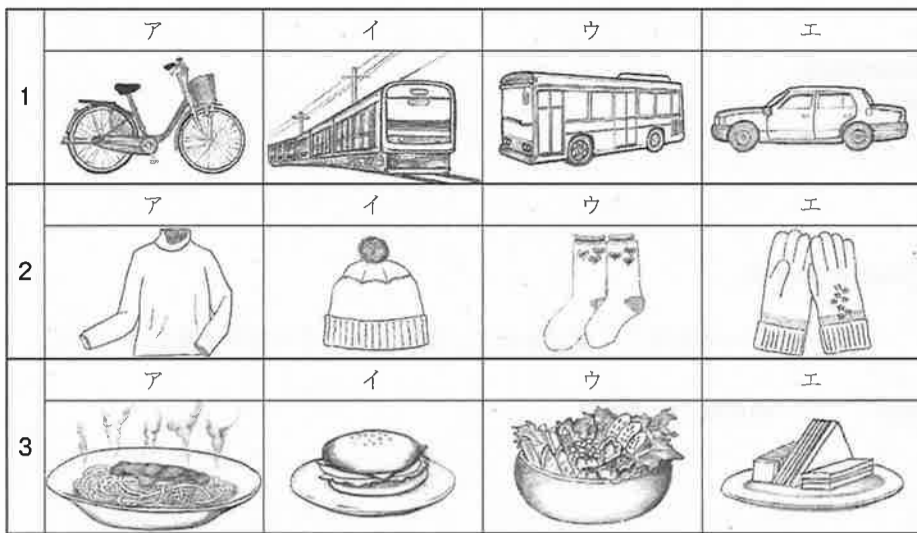

 Mr. Jones : That sounds interesting.
